3 26-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act and Section 7 and 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offenses Act, 2012.

Name of the petitioner surfaced in the confessional statement of co-accused Mithilesh Rajak who was arrested at the spot. The allegation is of involvement in immoral trafficking.

Submission is that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact that there is no substantial material against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a



period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Patliputra Police Station Case No. 264 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
