ORAL ORDER

3 18-05-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Hisua P.S.Case No.241 of 2016 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 354(B), 379, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of assault to the informant causing injury to him.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that earlier to that sister of the petitioner had filed a case under Section 498A of the IPC and thereafter a case has been lodged by the *Sautan* of the sister of the petitioner stating that they have assaulted and the injuries are on the hand and head. Opinion was found reserved.



Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Nawada in connection with Hisua P.S.Case no.241 of 2016, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid direction, this application is allowed.
