the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in Chand P.S.Case No. 5 of
2018 instituted for the offence under Section(s) 302, 120B/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

In the written report, allegation against this petitioner is of
committing murder of father of the informant with fire arm.

Learned counsel for the informant has appeared and opposed
the prayer for bail
