ORAL ORDER

4 13-08-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Mufassil P.S.Case No.345 of 2017 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 506, 504 and 384 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he has taken Rs.3 lac from the informant for providing job and when he demanded money the petitioner started avoiding the informant and thereafter the informant lodged FIR; on which the petitioner started threatening to kidnap him and also realized Rs.3 lac.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has been falsely implicated in this case and in a earlier case cognizance had been taken only under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act and the allegation of kidnapping or



realization of Rs.3 lac is false and concocted.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Siwan in connection with Mufassil P.S.Case No.345 of 2017 subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid direction, this application is allowed.
