learned counsel for the respondents.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has made her claim for benefits of her
employment with effect from the date of counselling, i.e.,

including seniority has been granted to the other two candidates

petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.4 to
take a final decision in respect of petitioner's claim made in her
representation within a period of eight weeks from the date of
receipt/production of a copy of this order.
