ORAL ORDER

3 25-08-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Rajapakar P.S.Case No.72 of 2018 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149,341, 323, 337, 504, 506,353, 307, 427 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Allegation against the petitioner and the other accused persons is of assaulting on the bride in the marriage.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the present FIR has been lodged by the uncle of the bride and another FIR was lodged by the brother of the brother and the petitioner has not been named in this FIR and due to enmity he has been named in the present FIR.



Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Rajapakar P.S.Case No.72 of 2018 subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid direction, this application is allowed.
