APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 447, 384, 387, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution case, in short, is that when the informant along with his son objected to the cultivating of their land, the accused persons abused them and further demanded rangdari from them.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the



petitioners. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case. The alleged occurrence is said to have taken place due to land dispute. None is said to have been injured in course of occurrence. As far as offence under under Section 384 IPC is concerned, the same is superficial in nature.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Khagaria in connection with Gogri P.S. Case No. 468 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
