Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondents.

This writ application has been filed for quashing the order dated 21.06.2014 passed by learned Subordinate Judge I, Bettiah, West Champaran in Title Suit No.58 of 2008 whereby and whereunder the amendment petition of the petitioner was rejected.
