counsel for the respondents.

The following reliefs have been sought for by the
petitioner in the present writ application.

“1. That this writ application is being filed
for issuance of an appropriate writ/writs
and order/orders in the nature of
mandamus for directing and commanding



the respondents to pay the arrear of salary as difference of arrears of revised pay scale in terms of the U.G.C. to the petitioner for the period of 1995 to July, 2013 with 12% interest.”

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the order passed by another co-ordinate Bench of this Court in C.W.J.C. No. 4573 of 2017 dated 05.12.2017.
