ORAL ORDER

2 05-09-2018 Based on National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test, held by the Central Board of Secondary Education, the petitioner has been allotted MBBS seat in Anugrah Narayan Magadh Medical College, Gaya, in the last mop-up round of counselling. He has a grievance that candidates lower in merit have been allotted MBBS seats in PMCH, IGIMS and NMCH whereas the petitioner has been denied, though PMCH was his top priority.

The dates for admission are over. The court does not find any reason to interfere with the decision of the Bihar Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board (BCECEB), taken after completion of process of counselling.



This Court, however, directs the Controller of Examination, BCECEB to find out as to why the persons in lower merit have been allotted MBBS seats in PMCH, IGIMS and NMCH and denying the claim of more meritorious candidates. The Controller of Examination shall consider taking corrective steps, if so required, for the future.
