2 18-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This writ application relates to admission in B.Ed. courses for the academic session 2018-20 in the institution in question, which claims to be having the minority status; on the basis of Combined Entrance Test, held by the Nalanda Open University, as a Nodal body.



This is not in dispute that the last date permitted for admitting the students in B.Ed. Course has already lapsed. In such circumstance, no relief can be granted to these petitioners.

This application has become infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.

The legal issues which have been raised in the present writ application have not been gone into, in view of the changed situation. Needless to say that the parties shall be at liberty to raise such issues in appropriate proceeding, in future.
