6 04-05-2018 The following reliefs have been sought for in the present application on behalf of the petitioner.

“1. That this is an application for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order dated 16.7.2011 containing in Memo No.775 dated 16.7.2011, issued by the office of District Teacher Employment Appellate Authority, Vaishali whereby and whereunder the application filed



by this petitioner against the decision of Gram Panchayat Raj Baksama, Block Garaul District Vaishali has been rejected on the ground stated in the impugned order.”
