ORAL ORDER

2 30-11-2018 The petitioner has challenged the order passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Sadar Gaya, dated 07.01.2017 on the ground that 24 hours notice was granted to the petitioner to file reply to the show cause.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present case is squarely covered by a judgment reported in *2013(1) PLJR 718 [Smt. Fulpati Devi vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.]*.

In view of the aforesaid, the order passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Sadar Gaya is quashed and the Sub-Divisional Officer, Sadar Gaya is directed to issue a fresh show cause notice giving sufficient time to the petitioner to file reply to the show cause and after seeking reply from the petitioner, the



Sub-Divisional Officer, Sadar Gaya shall pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receiving of the reply to the show cause.

With the aforesaid direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
