ORAL ORDER

2 14-12-2018 The only grievance which the petitioners has is that the State Government of Bihar is yet to take a decision on the question of grant of approval of permanent affiliation under Section 21(2) (d) of the Bihar State Universities Act, 1976. It is specific case of the petitioners that the University has sent recommendation to the State Government for grant of desired approval way back in 2013.

2. In view of the nature of grievance which the



petitioners has raised, this application is being disposed of with a direction to the Respondent Nos. 1,2 and 3 to ensure that a decision is taken on the point of grant of approval of affiliation within two months from the day of receipt/production of a copy of this order, if the matter is pending with the State Government.
