3 17-01-2018 This appeal has been filed for setting aside the order

dated 10.8.2016 passed by Additional Sessions Judge-I, Nawada

and for grant of bail.

Appellant is that appellant is named in the FIR and there
is allegation against him. Further, cognizance has been taken in
this case.

Submission of learned counsel for the appellant is that
earlier appeal filed by the appellant was dismissed for default and
another co-accused having similar allegation has been granted bail
by this Court vide order dated 1.9.2017 passed in Cr.Appeal (SJ)
No. 2045 of 2017. Further submission is that in this case final
