In view of the fact that a forum has been created for deciding all the disputes of the affiliated college vide notification dated 19.05.2015, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Pradhikar constituted under the Bihar Anudanit Shikshan Sansthan Pradhikar Niyamawali, 2015.

In the event such petition is filed by the petitioner along with a copy of this order, the Pradhikar will entertain the petition and dispose of the same after condoning the delay, if any.



In view of the statutory scheme, the Pradhikar is vested with power for grant of interim relief and in case the petitioner files petition for grant of interim relief, Pradhikar is expected to dispose of the petition for grant of interim relief at the earliest preferably within a period of one month from the date of filing of such petition for interim relief.

With the aforesaid, the writ application stands disposed of.
