The present writ petition has been filed for quashing the notice dated 09.08.2011 issued by the Certificate Officer in Certificate Case No. 05/2011-12 as also the notice dated 02.08.2011 issued by the Block Development Officer, Dehri by which the petitioners have been directed to deposit the amounts towards undistributed food grains lifted under the SGRY Scheme.



3. Learned counsel for the respondents appears and states that pursuant to the orders of this Court, the Enquiry Commission headed by Hon’ble Mr. Justice Udai Sinha (Retired) has now submitted its report and any further action in relation to recovery of the value of undistributed rice under the SGRY Scheme would abide by the decision of the State Government to be taken on the basis of such report.
