ORAL ORDER

2 15-01-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners. No one appears on behalf of the State.

Apprehending their arrest in complaint case no. 374 of 2017 registered under Sections 323, 406 and 504/34 of the IPC and Section 138 of the N.I. Act, the petitioners have approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail.

After placing the complaint learned counsel submits that the allegation of giving cash amount by the complainant is to co accused Krishna Prasad Keshri being the son of petitioner no.1, who instead of returning the amount in cash issued two cheques which got dishonored. Petitioners are only the family members.



The allegation is that complainant when went to demand money from co-accused Krishna Prasad Keshri they abused and fisted.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, named above, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Bhabhua in connection with Complaint case no. 374 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with further condition that one of the bailors in each case shall be the own/close family member.
