Magistrate, refused to pass any order in favor of the appellant,
who was the petitioner before the Writ Court.

interfere and set aside the order of the District Magistrate or the learned Single Judge who dismissed the writ application on 15.11.2016.

Appeal has no merit. It is dismissed.
