2 15-03-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 2 regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 2 be directed to dispose off the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances before the respondent no. 2 within two weeks and in case such representation is filed, then the same may be considered and disposed off within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the said representation by a speaking and reasoned order.



In case any admitted amount is found to be payable, the same shall be paid within a period of four weeks from passing of the final order.

The writ petition is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
