authority under the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act and on the same being done, the statutory authority shall proceed to decide the application/complaint in accordance to the statutory provision after hearing all concerned and if encroachment is found to be existing, the same shall be removed, preferably within a period of six months.

With the aforesaid, the matter stands disposed of.
