2 02-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is apprehending his arrest
in connection with Complaint Case No. 801C/2016 registered for
offences under sections 109, 468, 420B/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

The petitioner is an official of the Government of
Bihar. An allegation has been made of wrong mutation of the land
of the Informant which is completely a civil dispute related to
revenue.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the
case, let the petitioner, namely, Ashok Singh, in the event of his



arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jamui in connection with Complaint Case No. 801C/2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
