2 11-09-2018 At the out set, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present writ petition qua the petitioner no.3. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as far as the petitioner no.3 is concerned.

The short grievance raised by the surviving petitioners is regarding pendency of their case for regularization/absorption on Class-III post.
