2 17-07-2018 Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we direct that pending finalization of the criminal case (Balarampur (Telta) P.S. Case No. 86 of 2018) vehicle of the petitioner (Apache Motorcycle) bearing Regn. No.BR 11AC 4563 be released to the petitioner on the petitioner furnishing two sureties to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate, Katihar. Valuation of the vehicle in question shall be done as per the valuation shown in the insurance documents.

The vehicle in question shall be released within a week from the date of furnishing the sureties.

The applicability of Section 56, in the facts and



circumstances of the case, shall be considered and decided
before proceeding with the confiscation proceedings.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed
of.
