the petitioners in the present writ application.

“1. That the petitioners above named
pray for issuance of a writ preferably in the
nature of Mandamus commanding and
directing the Respondents concerned to make
payment of differential salary for the period
1.1.1996 to December, 2005 by virtue of
promotion as Associate Professor/Reader as
despite their promotion petitioners were paid



the salary for the post of Lecturers. And/or any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioners are found entitled to in the facts and circumstances of this case.”
