The petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

- “(i) For passing a writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other writ order or direction commanding the Respondent for paying the dues of the petitioner pursuant to the agreement for the year 2016-17 amount to Rs. 10, 17, 236 (428.13 quintals CMR @ 2376 per quintals) for supply of 428.13 quintals CMR, with penal interest as despite several reminders and notices the same has not been paid.
- (ii) Any other writ or order or direction to which the petitioner is found by this Hon’ble Court may kindly be issued.”

In view of the aforesaid, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Respondent No. 2 / 3 by filing a representation within a period of four weeks from today and in case, such a representation is filed, the same shall be disposed of by the Respondent No. 2 / 3 by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of eight



thereafter.

It is further directed that in case, the authorities find that any admitted outstanding dues is pending for payment, the same should be paid within a period of eight weeks of the decision to be taken by the Respondent No. 2 / 3 failing which the outstanding amount of due shall carry an interest of 18% per annum.
