The issue raised in the present writ application is no more *res integra*.

In the matter of compassionate appointment, the issue was finally decided by the Apex Court in the case of **Mukesh & Ano. Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.**, reported in (2017) 5 SCC 383.

In view of the principle laid down by the Apex Court in the case of **Mukesh & Ano.** (supra), the writ application is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take appropriate decision with regard to the claim of the petitioner within a maximum period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of



this order and grant all consequential benefits, if the petitioner is entitled to such benefit in terms of the judgment of the Apex Court in the case of **Mukesh & Ano.** (supra).
