Learned counsel for the State submits that pursuant to the directions, the petitioner has been paid his 62 months salary, as is evident from paragraph 5 of the show cause filed on behalf of Opposite Party No.6. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that the salary for four months still remains unpaid.

Considering the fact that there has been substantial



compliance of the order passed by this Court, the contempt application stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise any grievance, which may be tenable under law.
