counsel for the respondents.

The present application has been filed for modification
of order dated 11.10.2017 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 10803 of 2011
by which the writ petition was disposed of with liberty to the
petitioner to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority,



within a period of thirty days from the date of order i.e., 11.10.2017.
