2 09-05-2018 It appears that in the order dated 14.3.2018 the description of the petitioners in C.W.J.C. No. 210 of 2018 was typed out as per the description in the writ application.

Now the petitioners have filed a petition for correction



of name and details of the petitioner nos.1, 3, 6 and 7 on account of the error occurred in the pleading itself.
