Considering the fact that in the writ petition, this Court did not issue any mandamus or direction, only found that the State Government, under the statute is not liable to make payment, therefore, only observed that the State Government may take a policy decision with regard to grant in aid to the Committee in question.

Keeping in view the same, and the manner in which



the writ petition was disposed of now merely because no grant is sanctioned, we see no reason to initiate a proceeding as no positive direction or mandamus was issued in the writ petition. The observation was only a passing remark to the State Government to consider the grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the same, this application stands dismissed.
