2 13-02-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the Annexure-3 and 4 to the writ petition which is dated 12.12.2013 and has been issued by the Deputy Collector (Establishment), Patna the petitioner herein has been acquitted of the charges alleged in the on going departmental proceeding, hence he prays that the arrears of outstanding salary be paid to him.
