In the writ petition, the only direction to the Circle Officer, respondent no.6, was to conclude the encroachment proceedings and from the show cause filed, we find that the encroachment proceedings have been concluded and, therefore, now, no further action is required to be taken in this application. In case, in the final order passed, encroachment is found to be



established, then petitioners may resort to such steps as may be permissible in law for execution of the order passed by the executive officer and removal of the encroachment.
