Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances pertaining to non-payment of arrears of salary and the grant of benefits of 5th pay revision within a period of two weeks from today before the respondent no. 3 and the respondent no. 3 is directed to dispose off the said representation of the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter by a speaking and reasoned order keeping
