Petitioner may represent the respondent nos.1 and 2 with regard to the issue in question. It would be for the respondent nos.1 and 2 to take action in the matter. If still aggrieved, the petitioner will have liberty to take recourse to common remedy of filing a civil suit in the matter and seek injunction therein.
