3 25-01-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in connection with
Madhuban P.S. Case No.131 of 2016, registered under Sections
304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code as well as under Sections 3/4
of the D.P. Act.

Allegation in brief is that the deceased was married with
the petitioner four years back, she was tortured in connection
with further demand of dowry and on account of that she was
killed and dead body was disposed of.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is husband, in fact the deceased died of diarrhea and
now even the informant has also entered into compromise.



Having considered the nature of offence and the petitioner is husband, the prayer of bail of the petitioner is rejected in connection with Madhuban P.S. Case No.131 of 2016, pending in the court of learned A.C.J.M., 4th, East Champaran, Motihari, at this stage.

However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and preferably conclude the same within 18 months.
