3 15-01-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

learned APP for the State.

Petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in connection

with Nokha P.S. Case No.254 of 2016, registered under Sections

8(C), 20(B), 22, 27(A) and 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

Allegation in brief is that 124 Kgs. of *Ganja* was

recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

samples extracted from the seized *Ganja* was not according to the

law as *Ganjas* were taken out from each packet and mixed, so

there is bleak chance of conviction. He further submits that the

Ganja was kept there by one other co-accused Sanjay Bharti.

Having considered the huge quantity of *Ganja*



recovered from the house of the petitioner, the prayer of bail of the petitioner is rejected in connection with Nokha P.S. Case No.254 of 2016, pending in the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-IV, Sasaram, District Rohtas.

However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and preferably conclude the same within a year.
