2 07-05-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if she is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 5 regarding her grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 5 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.
