Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner has been in custody since 20.06.2016  
in connection with Bairstania P.S. Case No. 93/2016 registered for  
the offences punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal  
Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that  
though the fatal blow has been attributed to the petitioner by the  
informant, she is not the eye-witness.

Learned counsel for the State after perusal of the case  
diary submits that there is cogent material in the case diary  
including the statement of the independent eye-witness which goes  
to show that the petitioner had, in fact, attacked with a knife and it  
is the knife-blow which alone led to the death of the husband of  
the informant.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant regular bail to this petitioner. It is accordingly rejected.

The trial of the case, however, may be expedited so as to conclude within a period of nine months from today.
