The petitioner has been in custody since 22.12.2017 in
connection with Mahkar P.S. Case No. 77/2016 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 304(b)/201/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is not
a case under Section 304(B) of the Indian Penal Code as the
marriage took place in the year 2008. Moreover, there is no
allegation that the petitioner had participated in the occurrence and
the allegation is general and omnibus in nature.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant is
present and resists the application for bail.

Considering the period of custody and that the
petitioner is the Dewar in a case under Section 304(b), let the



petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate-IX, Gaya, in connection with Mahkar P.S. Case No. 77/2016.
