ORAL ORDER

2 02-02-2018 Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Maharajganj P.S.Case No. 168 of 2017 registered for the offences under Sections 302 and 210/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners and other accused persons of causing death of the deceased, who happened to be daughter of the informant and wife of one co-accused.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that petitioners are only family members and husband of deceased is in



custody and there is no specific allegation against them.

Heard learned APP also.

In the facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-V, Siwan, in connection with Maharajganj P.S. Case No. 168 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further conditions that (1) one of the bailors shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of court concerned and (2) petitioners will co-operate in investigation and will appear before the Investigating Officer as and when required, except on genuine reason, failing which their bail bonds shall be cancelled.
