3 28-11-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Maner P.S.Case No.258 of 2018 dated 28.5.2018 registered for
offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 304(B), 120(B) and
34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner id of dowry death against
the petitioner, who happens to be cousin father -in- law of the
deceased.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner there
is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and
nothing specific has been attributed against him. He is in
custody since 2.8.2018.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Miss Nutan Kumari, J.M. Ist Class, Danapur in connection with Maner P.S.Case No.258 of 2018 dated 28.5.2018..

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
