Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This is an appeal under Section 14(A)(2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 against the refusal of prayer for bail by order dated 01.09.2018 in Vaishali P.S. Case No.155 of 2018 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-I, Vaishali at Hajipur, registered under Sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 27 of the Arms Act and Section 3(i)R, 3(i) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

On the order of this appellant, co-accused- Sanjiv Kumar and Abhay Kumar caught to the father of the informant and co-accused-Dhiraj Kumar indiscriminately fired causing injury and death of the



father of the informant. Appellant is in custody since 04.07.2018. Investigation of the case is already complete. There is no allegation of tampering with the evidence.

Considering the nature of allegation against the appellant, let the appellant, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with the aforesaid case, with condition that both bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below and further the appellant shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and this appeal stands allowed.
