**ORAL ORDER**

4      18-06-2018      Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Sheosagar P.s.Case No.346/17 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 354/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of POCSO Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is of kidnapping the daughter of the informant.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., she has not named the petitioner, she has also stated that she had love affair with Awanit Kumar Ram and she had gone along with him on her own sweet-will.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M., Rohtas at Sasaram in connection with Sheosagar P.S.Case no.346 of 2017, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid direction, this application is allowed.
