In view of the fact that the State Government has constituted a forum by notification dated 19.5.2015 for adjudication of the dispute pertaining to distribution of the fund allocated by the State Government under the *Bihar Anudanit Shikshan Sansthan Pradhikar Nimawali, 2015*, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the *Pradhikar* constituted under the aforesaid rule within a period of



one month from today along with a copy of this order. In the event such petition is filed by the petitioner before the *Pradhikar*, the *Pradhikar* is required to decide the case of the petitioner in accordance with law after opportunity to all likely to be adversely affected by the decision expeditiously preferably within a period of four months from the date of filing of such petition along with a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
