4 10-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case he is granted liberty to file representation before the respondent no.2 and the respondent no.2 may be directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioner within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner shall file a representation before the respondent no.2 regarding his grievances raised in the writ petition within a period of two weeks from today and the respondent no.2 is directed to dispose of the same within a period of eight weeks thereafter.



The present writ petition is disposed off on the aforesaid terms.

It is needless to state that the consequential benefits i.e. the differential amount of salary, if found payable, should be paid within a period of eight weeks of the final decision to be taken by the Vice-Chancellor, failing which the authorities shall be liable for penal consequences.
