The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned authority to dispose of his grievances regarding non-payment of arrears of salary pertaining to the strike period.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation before the respondent no.3 within a period of two weeks from today with regard to his grievances and the respondent no.3 is directed to dispose of the said representation within a period of four weeks thereafter by a reasoned and speaking order.



It is further directed that in case the authorities pass a positive order, then all the consequential benefits/ arrears, as aforesaid, shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of passing of the order.

The writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
