The present writ petition has been filed for a direction upon the respondent authorities to consider the case of the petitioner for a new license under P.D.S. on the basis of compassionate grounds in place of his father.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it will suffice if the petitioner is permitted to approach the Sub-Divisional Officer, Araria (respondent no. 3) with a fresh representation for redressal of his grievances raised in the present writ petition, in which event, the present writ petition need not be pressed on merits.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents appears and has been heard.



4. Having regard to the nature of the grievanc es and the stand of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh representation before the Sub-Divisional Officer, Araria (respondent no. 3) for redressal of his grievances. If any such representation is filed within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be considered and disposed of expeditiously and preferably within a further period of eight weeks thereafter in accordance with law.
