ORAL ORDER

4 13-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Accountant General, Bihar, Patna.

Petitioner is the first wife of respondent no. 6, late Dr. Majhar Bari and claims 50% of the pension amount of respondent no. 6 as she is not being maintained by her husband.

Considering the nature of claim as made by the petitioner, let the petitioner approach the respondent authorities by way of representation which will be disposed of by the respondent no. 2, the Director, Animal Husbandry Department, Government of Bihar, Patna within a period of two months from



the date of receipt of such representation. Any calculation done towards retiral benefits would be paid to the petitioner within one month thereafter. If any dues are in admissible, the same shall be communicated to the petitioner by speaking order through registered post.
