ORAL ORDER

2 07-12-2018 Heard Mr. Sandeep Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Naresh Chandra Verma, learned counsel for the respondent No.6 as well as learned A.C. to S.C.25 appearing on behalf of the State.

By the impugned order, the learned Member(Administrative), B.L.T. set aside the order of the Sub-Divisional Officer, Gopalganj and remanded the case to the Court of Sub-Divisional Officer, Gopalganj to examine the case afresh in accordance with law. Since the matter has been remanded for consideration to the Court of Sub-Divisional Officer to consider the matter afresh, I do not find any illegality



in the order. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed with observation that both the parties may appear before the Court of Sub-Divisional Officer, Gopalganj who shall consider the case of the petitioner and respondent in accordance with law.
